

## Mount Olivet Yearly Collection

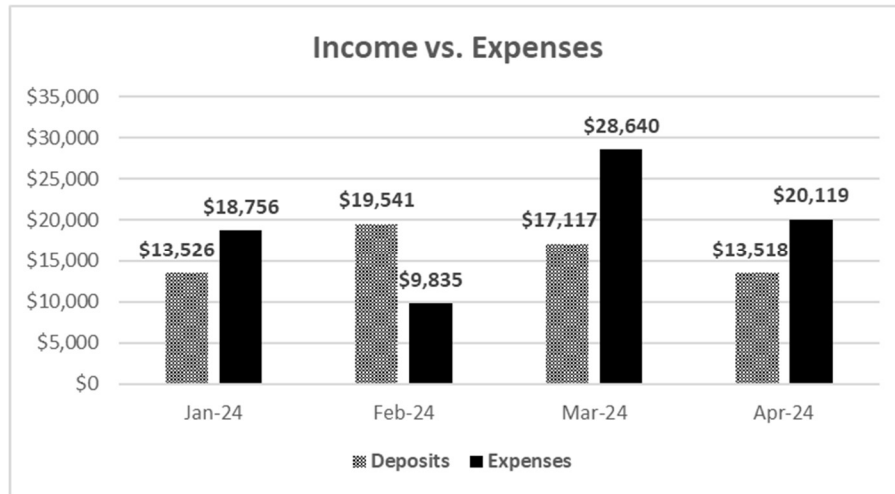
